HISTORIC ROOTS

The Mansion House predates the zoo itself. Built in 1793, it was originally known as Corstorphine Hill House and served as a private residence before being incorporated into the zoo when it opened in 1913.

The building showcases stunning Victorian architecture, including ornate detailing, high ceilings and grand windows. Its design reflects the sophistication of the 18th and 19th centuries, making it a highlight for guests.

RZSS has pledged to reverse the decline of at least 50 species by 2030, including pine hoverflies and wildcats in the Cairngorms National Park, chimpanzees in Uganda, giant anteaters in Brazil, and many more.


