## STAYING SAFE IN THE DRIVE-THROUGH AREAS

- Please stay in your vehicle, do not feed or try to touch the animals through your window and please remember that the animals have right of way.
- If stopping, pull over on the left-hand side to allow others to pass. Be aware that park vehicles move around the drive-through reserve in the opposite direction so please pull over for oncoming park vehicles.
- Our charity cannot accept responsibility for any damage to vehicles in the drive-through areas or in the car parks.
