- No pets allowed** Only accredited guide dogs may enter the park.
- Lost children** Please ask any member of staff in the park for help.
- Toilets** located outside the Oystercatcher Café and overlooking the playpark.

- Card preferred** We accept most major credit and debit cards.
- Food & drink** Food available to take away or sit in from Oystercatcher (seasonal) and Antler cafés.
- Accessibility**
 - Both of our cafés are directly accessible to wheelchair users.
 - Disabled parking close to the cafés.
 - For disabled access to animals in the walking area, please ask a member of staff.
